1. Living – A village where everyone can live in peace and security
 - (1) Establish a village where the diversity is respected and residents proactively cooperate and live
 - Resident participation and cooperation
 - Open administrative management
 - Interaction and coexistence with diverse people
 - (2) Establish a village that supports a secure and safe life
 - Improvement of disaster prevention
 - Ensuring safety and security in daily life
 - (3) Establish a village that supports welfare and health

- Support for child-raising
 - Support for the disabled persons
 - Welfare for the senior residents
 - Promoting local healthcare services
- (4) Establish a village with independent, efficient, and sound financial management
- Utilization of Information and Communication Technology
 - Promotion of Administrative and Financial reform

2. Industry – A Village Creating New Careers

- (1) Creating a tourist village with a global standard
- Management of tourist village for competitiveness and sustainability
- (2) Village development that preserves farmland and forests and makes the most of local products
- Preservation of fine agricultural land
 - Branding of agricultural products, promotion of production and sales of specialties
 - Forest Maintenance and Utilization
- (3) Establish a village that promotes commerce and industry to enhance employment opportunities
- Promotion of commercial and industrial development, and support for business establishment
- (4) Establish a village that takes advantage of private-sector vitality
- Collaboration on the part of industry, government and academia.

3. Individual – A village where each individual can grow and be active

- (1) Establish of a village where people learn and grow together
- Supporting the next generation's children in their education
 - Lifelong learning and youth development
- (2) Establish a village where people can enjoy sports throughout their lives
- Promoting health and vitality through sports
- (3) Establish a village where each and every individual has a place to be active in the community
- Creating vitality through connections with others
 - Promoting a gender-equal society

4. Nature – A village where preserves an attractive natural environment

- (1) Establish a village that protects the invaluable natural mountain environment
- Co-Existence with nature
 - Utilization of the natural energy
- (2) Establish a village that inherits a way of life with nature
- Inheritance of the history and culture of the hometown to be preserved
- (3) Establish a village that preserves and cultivates beautiful landscapes
