


② “Kinzoku” ~ Metals

Where?

- Ward garbage station
- Hakuba Sanroku Clean Center

【 Empty steel cans 】



- Steel cans with this recycling mark 
- Food cans, spray cans, etc.
- ※ Rinse the can.
- ※ Punch a hole to degas a gas cartridge
- ※ Acceptable size of a can is up to 18 L.

【 Metals 】



- Pot, kettle, fry pan or other metallic products
- Nail, needle, pin, knife, etc
- ※ When dispose of sharp objects like nails and needles, put them in a can and label it 「キケン」 (dangerous) to keep the collector safe.

③ “Kami” ~ Paper containers & packaging

Where?

- Ward garbage station
- Hakuba Sanroku Clean Center
- Matsukawa Bulky Waste station



【 Pay attention to this mark ! 】

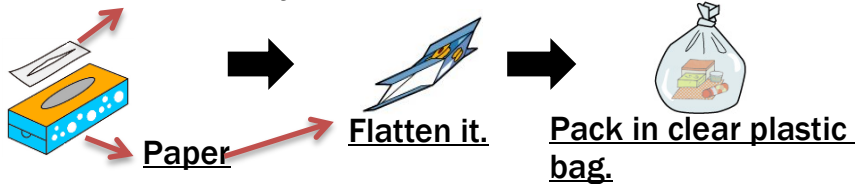


- Tissue box, snacks box, gift wrapping, etc.
- Paper bags

※ Items with unremovable stink or dirt should be thrown away as “① Burnable garbage”.

How To

E.g. Remove objects other than paper.



※ You may also pack them into a paper bag which has the recycling mark on it. Tie it tightly with strings to prevent the contents from spilling out.

④ “Kami-pakku” ~ Paper beverage cartons

【 Pay attention to this mark ! 】



- Milk, juice, tea carton, etc.
- ※ The inside must be white in colour.
- ※ Remove the plastic parts if any.

How To

Wash & dry it.

Open it.

Bundle with string.
