3 Ward Garbage Station (calendar)

Hakuba Village consists of 30 administrative wards ("Chiku"), each ward has its own committee ("Jichikai"), operating by ward residents, to manage the community affairs. The garbage stations ("Gomi-Syusekijo") are under the management of each corresponding Chiku, opening for the residents who have joined Jichikai.

The Jichikai members can dispose of their home garbage to the nearest garbage station which belongs to their Chiku. The collection day of each type of garbage is shown below.

= What =

Ward garbage stations accept 15 types of garbage / recyclable materials. Only household garbage is allowed. For business garbage, please see p.8.

= **How** =

Sort the garbage into groups by following the guidelines on the left and p.9-16. Put them out at the station on the designated collection day.

= When =

Put the garbage out between 6 P.M. on the day before and 8 A.M. on the collection day.

E.g. Collection Day \sim Monday



= Where =

There may be multiple garbage stations in the ward you are belonging to.

Please consult the ward mayor or visit your neighbours to confirm which station you can use.

= **Who** =

The ward garbage stations only open to paid members. Before the first use of ward garbage station, you must confirm your membership with the Jichikai.

Besides ward garbage stations, you may also dispose of the household garbage at Hakuba Sanroku Clean Center. However, acceptable garbage / recyclable materials are different at Clean Center. See p. 6-7 for more details.
