

1 Types of Garbage & Recyclable Materials in Hakuba



Garbage “Gomi” is basically classified into 19 categories in Hakuba.

< ” ” The name commonly called in Japanese.>

① Burnable garbage “ <i>Moeru-gomi</i> ”	② Metals “ <i>Kinzokurui</i> ”
③ Paper containers & packaging “ <i>Kami</i> ”	④ Paper beverage cartons “ <i>Kami-pakku</i> ”
⑤ Corrugated cardboard “ <i>Danbouru</i> ”	⑥ Newspaper & leaflet “ <i>Shinbunshi / chirashi</i> ”
⑦ Magazine & waste paper “ <i>Zasshi/Zatsu-gami</i> ”	⑧ Plastic containers & packaging “ <i>Pura</i> ”
⑨ White tray “ <i>Shiroi-torei</i> ”	⑩ Plastic(PET) bottles “ <i>Petto-botoru</i> ”
⑪ Glass bottles “ <i>Garasu-bin</i> ”	⑫ Aluminium cans “ <i>Arumi-kan</i> ”
⑬ Clothes & cloth “ <i>Iru</i> ”	⑭ Glass & pottery scraps “ <i>Garasu/toujiki-kuzu</i> ”
⑮ Dry cell battery “ <i>Kandenchi</i> ”	⑯ Fluorescent lamp “ <i>Keikoutou</i> ”
⑰ Mercury thermometer “ <i>Suigin-ondoker</i> ”	⑱ Small-scale home appliances “ <i>Kogata-kaden</i> ”
⑲ Bulky waste “ <i>Sodai-gomi</i> ”	

There is specific detailed guidance on each type of “gomi”; Generally speaking, you will need to sort, clean and dry them, and then put them in bags or bundle them with string by item.

You should confirm the collection timetable / opening hours and particular rules of each of the garbage collection facility before putting out your garbage.
