I would like to take this opportunity to welcome the New Year of 2025 and wish you all a glorious new year filled with hope. I would like to express my sincere appreciation for your deep understanding and cooperation in all aspects of our village administration.

This winter has been very fortunate to have had a steady snowfall since December, and we are very happy to welcome many guests from Japan and abroad. We hope that you fully enjoy the world-class mountain scenery and natural environment, the culture and hospitality of the region, and experience the charm of Hakuba Village to the fullest.

Looking back on last year, Mr. Yuro Nagahara became the first Hakuba Village athlete to

compete in the Summer Olympics, and he showed us his courage in taking on the challenging tasks on the big stage in Paris. Not only Mr. Nagahara, but also other Hakuba villagers of all ages who are active in sports both in Japan and overseas contribute to the vitality of the local community.



In addition, to mark the 10th anniversary of the Kamishiro Earthquake, we held a symposium to pass on the experience and lessons learned from the earthquake, and designated November 22 as the Hakuba- Otari Earthquake Disaster Prevention Day. In preparation for disasters that may occur regardless of when or where, we cooperate with local residents and businesses in disaster prevention and disaster reduction efforts.

On the Tourism area, Hakuba Village was certified under the "Japanese Sustainable Tourism Guidelines" (JSTS-D), and together with the Best Tourism Village by the UN Tourism, we were the first in Japan to receive the "International Certification Logo Mark". Furthermore, Hakuba Village Tourism Organization was selected as the nation's fourth "Pioneering DMO," and a system is now in place to accelerate efforts to create a world-class sustainable tourism region.

Hakuba Village is now in the process of updating its Comprehensive Plan, which determines the basic policies for town development, and its Tourism Destination Management Plan, which determines what it should aim to become as a tourist destination. Since last year, we have provided many opportunities to hear from our residents about their problems, wishes and requests for the future through surveys, round-table meetings with each district, thematic town meetings, and the on-site mayor's office. Although there are many issues in the community, we are committed to creating a town where all villagers can continue to live happily by enriching the community through the promotion of tourism and further improving the welfare of residents.

At last, I would like to conclude my New Year's greetings by wishing you all a happy and wonderful new year.

International Drivers License



BE AWARE

Please be aware that your regular international Drivers License/permit does not allow you to drive **10 seater vehicles** in Japan

E.g. Toyota Hi-Ace, Nissan Caravan. With International Drivers License: "B" Category / Taiwanese Drivers License: "Small Passenger Car" Category

If the vehicle has a capacity of 10 passengers as shown on the Vehicle Inspection Certificate (Shaken), the driver is considered to be driving without a license, even if the actual occupant is only the driver. There have been cases of drivers having accidents, but insurance companies will not cover the damage costs. You will also be charged a high penalty for driving with an invalid license.

If you're driving a large 10 seater van, you are required to have a special license/permit, issued by your home country. For business owners, please double check your employees' driving permission before letting them drive.

FY2025 Final Tax Return (Kakutei-Shinkoku) & Resident Tax (Juminzei) Return

Date February 17 (Mon) – March 17 (Mon) Weekday AM 9:00-11:00 PM13:30-16:00

Resident Tax (Juminzei) is a local tax which is levied on the residents who have a registered address in Hakuba as of <u>January 1st</u> every year. You will be unable to obtain an "Income Certificate" if you do not submit a tax return. Besides, you might be charged a higher Health Insurance Tax based on our estimated calculation.

The following residents are responsible for filing a Resident Tax Return:

- ▶ Those who have **not** completed the year-end tax adjustment.
- Those who <u>have completed</u> the year-end tax adjustment, but <u>have an income other than that salary.</u>
 *You must report your additional income, regardless of the amount, for calculating the Resident Tax.
- Those who have no income on last year.

The items required for submitting the tax return

- Passport, Residence Card
- ② Record of withholding income tax (Gensen-choshu-hyo) or salary details
- ③ Receipts of Medical expenses ·Social insurance premium ·Life insurance premium, etc.
- ④ Bank book or materials with your bank details (for receiving the tax return if any)
