Priority support benefits (100,000 yen payment) for soaring prices of electricity, qas, food goods, etc.

In light of the increase in burdens caused by soaring prices of electricity, gas, foodstuffs, etc., Japanese government provide **100,000 yen** per household newly exempted from residence tax or taxed only on per capita basis in fiscal 2024. Also, 50,000 yen for each household member under 18 years old will be provide.

Households that fall under any of the following are eligible.

- Household newly exempted from residence tax, or only taxed capita basis($\frac{4}{5}$,500/year) in FY2024 as of June 3rd,2024.
- Households that resided in Hakuba village as of January 1st.

Households that are **not** eligible for benefits





- Households that include those who have not yet declared their incomes in FY2023 (excluding those who are dependent on resident tax).
- Households that were eligible for the "Local Subsidy for Supporting Price Increases (70,000 yen per household)" and the "Priority Support Grant for Coping with Price Increases (100,000 yen per household)" in fiscal 2023 are not eligible, regardless of whether or not they received subsidies.


This will be the last time that insurance cards will be issued, as each insurance card will be transferred to the My Number Insurance Card.

Japan to put special alert system for heatstroke in place

This chart shows the maximum temperatures in August for the 20 years from 2003 to 2023. The number of days with over 30 degrees has increased dramatically over the past 20 years, and this year is expected to be extremely hot as well.



In 2023, Heat Stroke Alerts were issued 13 times in Nagano Prefecture. In April of this year, a new Heat Stroke Special Alert was added to the Heat Stroke Alerts. Heat Stroke Special Alerts are issued when there is a risk of serious damage to human health. Please check the news and weather forecasts and take protective actions such as refraining from outdoor activities and using air conditioning when an alert is issued.

Building Landscape Patrols have begun

In order to preserve the beauty of Hakuba Village, the Hakuba Village Landscape Ordinance was enacted in 2023, and the Hakuba Village Landscape Plan based on this ordinance established standards for the exterior wall color and shape of buildings and structures, building layout, and other aspects.

In 2024, in order to further develop the landscape, a landscape patrol has been conducted in cooperation with the Hakuba Building Industry Association.

The landscape patrol visits the site to check whether the colors used in new buildings and when repainting exterior walls accord with the standards of the Hakuba Village Landscape Plan. When patrol members visit a property, they may ask for your cooperation in confirming the status of the property.

In general, not only new buildings, but also the exterior walls and roofs of existing buildings must follow the standards of the Hakuba Village Landscape Plan, and notification must be made at least 30 days before construction work begins. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

A rise in aggressive encounters with wild animals has Japan in a slight panic



With bear attacks on humans at a record level, the Environment Ministry announced on April 16 that two species have been added to a list that allows for central government subsidies for culling and research purposes. "Higuma" brown bears and "Tsukinowaguma" Asiatic black bears were included on the designated controlled birds and animals list. Nagano Prefecture announced a "black bear alert" for the entire prefecture from June 5, 2024 to August 31, 2024. Hakuba Village has organized a "Mowing Week" to encourage residents to improve the environment and to maintain buffer zones near human habitat as a countermeasure against the increasing number of wildlife.

Buffer Zoning

Buffer zone maintenance means clearing away bushes, improving visibility, and creating a "buffer zone" between Forests along villages, farmlands, and roads to make it difficult for wild birds and animals to come out.

Satoyama Regeneration

Secondary forests of broadleaf trees (forests that have regenerated naturally after logging or other human activities have been added to the original natural forests) are distributed in the satoyama surrounding the village. The forest edges of satoyama are covered with vines and shrubs, forming a mantle forest community, causing an overcrowded high tree forest. This condition has persisted for a long time, making the boundary between the wildlife and human settlements unclear and providing a hiding place for them. In the past, satoyama were used as firewood and coal forests necessary for human life, but recently many forests are no longer used and are becoming suitable habitat for bears.

In order to reduce bear damage, zoning is important to separate the habitat of bears from the living areas of humans. Forests and abandoned farmland alongside houses and farmland provide routes for bears to travel and places to hide. Without good visibility, bears are more likely to appear in people's living areas, and sudden encounters with bears are more likely to occur. Riversides and riparian forests are also routes for bears to travel.

It is important to make the forests near villages less likely to be visited by bears daily by increasing human activities such as environmental improvement, hunting, log thinning, and use for recreation in these areas.
