## Hakuba Village Eco- friendly cars Purchase Promotion Project

### Subsidy

Villagers who purchase or lease EV cars or fuel cell cars (FCV) and meet all of the following conditions are eligible for the subsidy.

(1) The applicant must have continuously lived in Hakuba for at least a year as of the date of new registration of the EV or FCV.

\*In the case of a lease contract, the date of new registration is the date of use as stated in the lease contract.

(2) The applicant must not have any outstanding village taxes, etc.



### Amount of subsidy

**Purchase** • • • Up to 10% of the vehicle price (excluding tax), with a maximum of 300,000 yen.

**Lease** • • • The maximum amount of subsidy is 300,000 yen, within 7% of the lease payment (without tax) within the lease contract as stated in the lease contract.

<Note>

\*Amounts of less than 1,000 yen in the subsidy will be rounded down.

Subsidies will be granted only once per household, regardless of the number of electric vehicles purchased/leased.

Applications must be submitted within 90 days from the first day of the month following the month of new registration of the vehicle inspection certificate, or by March 31 of the subject fiscal year in which the subsidy is granted, whichever comes first.

## Help paying for HPV vaccine

Those who fall under the following are eligible for vaccination at public expense (no co-payment).

Notification will be sent to those

eligible during May or June. Please contact the Hakuba Village Child-Raising Support Division (Fureai center 3F) if applying for the vaccines. We will inform you of the details of the individual vaccination and send you a medical checkup sheet, etc.

## Regular vaccination eligibility

Females born between April 2, 2009 - April 1, 2014

Vaccination period: From April 1 of the year they turn 12-year-old to March 31 of the year they turn 16-year-old.

HPV vaccine will require a total of 2 to 3 doses depending on the type, and will take from 6 months to 1 year to complete.

## How National Health Insurance Tax is calculated?

Every resident of Japan has the obligation to subscribe for either one of the public health insurance programmes that allow them to be ready for illnesses and injuries at any time. (Universal Public Insurance System)

Japan's National Health Insurance (NHI) is supported by the regular NHI tax contributions from NHI members. NHI helps members pay part of the incurred medical costs from the tax pool.

$$\text{Annual NHI Tax} = \text{A} + \text{B} + \text{C} \times (\text{rounding A, B \& C down individually to the nearest hundred})$$

## Calculation of Annual NHI Tax Rate



**A Calculation of Medical care (basic) portion** = ① + ② + ③ (Max. amount: ¥660,000)

① Income portion = [Income of each working NHI member - ¥430,000] × **5.30%**

② Per-capita portion = Number of NHI member in the household × **¥18,900**

③ Household portion = Each household **¥17,700**

**B Calculation of Support to latter stage elderly portion** = ① + ② + ③ (Max. amount: ¥260,000)

① Income portion = [Income of each working NHI member - ¥430,000] × **2.80%**

② Per-capita portion = Number of NHI member in the household × **¥10,300**

③ Household portion = Each household **¥8,500**

**C Calculation of Nursing care portion** = ① + ② + ③ (Max. amount: ¥170,000)

① Income portion = [Income of each working NHI member (age 40 to 64) - ¥430,000] × **2.20%**

② Per-capita portion = Number of NHI member in the household (age 40 to 64) × **¥10,100**

③ Household portion = A household includes NHI members between age 40 and 64 **¥6,900**

## Tax Exemption for Prenatal and Postpartum Women Expecting a Childbirth

National Health Insurance members who are about to give birth are exempted from National Health Insurance tax for four months before and after childbirth (six months in the case of multiple births).

The term "childbirth" in this exemption system refers to deliveries of 85 days (4 months) or more of age and includes stillbirths, miscarriages (including artificial abortions), and premature births. The exemption period is from the month before the due date (three months before the due date in the case of multiple pregnancies) to the month following the due date.

# Age 20 and 30 were added to the Periodontal Disease Checkups in 2025

Periodontal disease is a major cause of tooth loss in middle-aged and over. In the early stages of the disease, there are few symptoms, and by the time symptoms are recognized, the disease has progressed considerably, often making it difficult to preserve teeth. The Village provides medical consultations, checkups, Periodontal Tissue Examinations, and oral health instructions at dental institutions every 10 years between the ages of 20 and 70, for the purpose of early detection of periodontal diseases and improvement of oral health awareness.

This year's eligible persons are those listed in the table. The co-payment for the checkup is 1,000 yen, and the village will subsidize 3,000 yen. Please make an appointment by phone at a dental institution in the Kita Alps region. The validity period is until February 28, 2025 (Friday).

(Please note that the tickets will be sent out from July to September in order to avoid overlapping appointments.)
