## **Disaster Drill in Hakuba**

Although Japan is modern and safe, emergencies and disasters can occur anywhere and at any time. Especially while living in a foreign country, language and cultural barriers can make your situation even worse when something unexpected happens.

Hakuba Village is going to hold a disaster drill on Sep 10 (Sun). Participants can learn how to protect themselves in a fire, how to use a fire distinguisher, AED machine and some basic first-aid skills.


