Last Call for Night Soil Collection Service

About Night Soil Collection:

The year-end is a peak demand period for night soil collection. If you need the toilet tank be cleaned out by the end of December, especially the accommodation facilities please make your request ASAP. For late requests, we **DO NOT guarantee** the service can be provided by the year-end.

Service during Winter:

Night soil collection service is also available during winter. However, it may be influenced by snowfall or traffic condition. For those who have requested the service in winter, <u>please remove the snow around</u> the toilet tank before the workers arrive.

Others:

- Do not dispose of sanitary products, plastics, slippers or other waste in the toilet tank.
- Please confirm the amount of drained waste on the receipt after the work is completed.

Final Reception of Home Waste Water Pumping in 2017:

The application for home waste water pumping is <u>ended by the end of November</u>. The service will be resumed in April according to the condition of snowfall.

The demand of service will come to a peak in late November. Please make a reservation as early as possible for a better arrangement.

Mutual Use of Public Libraries in North Alps IMC Bloc


From Oct 1, 2017, a resident from North Alps Inter-municipal Cooperation Bloc, comprises of five municipalities: Omachi, Ikeda, Matsukawa, Hakuba and Otari, can borrow books and other resources from all five public libraries.

To make use of the service:

You have to apply for a library card for each library. Please bring along an identity document, such as driving licence, health insurance card, residence card, etc. as an address proof.

Attentions :

- 1. Borrowed books must be returned to the belonged library.
- 2. Length of the rental period and borrowing limit may vary among libraries. Please confirm the terms of use with each library.
