#### 3. Basic Eligibility

- (1) The total income of the family must below the designated levels set forth in related public housing law <The level depends on the age and number of family members. One-person households may also apply.>
- (2) Those who have no delinquent tax. (3) Those who have difficulties in affording a private housing.
- (4) Those who are not gang members.

#### 4. Households with higher priority

- (1) Single parent households with underage child (2) Disabled households
- (3) Senior households (all members are aged 60 and above; and / or with children under 18)
- (4) Households living in bad condition (5) Households with the intention to join the Volunteer Firefighters
- (6) Households with the intention to join the administrative community and take part in the events

#### **Influenza Vaccination Subsidy Scheme**

Influenza, commonly known as "the flu", is an infectious disease caused by an influenza virus.

The most common symptoms include: a high fever, runny nose, sore throat, muscle pains, headache, coughing, and feeling tired. The symptoms of the flu are similar to cold symptoms, but usually severer. Especially in elderly, the flu may cause complications such as pneumonia; the condition of chronic diseases may also get worsen.

Hakuba Village provides influenza vaccination subsidy to elderly and children. Recently, the village office has received reports from clinics that influenza cases have been confirmed in Hakuba In November. Please take this opportunity to help prevent your children and elderly at home from catching the flu.

**Influenza Vaccination Subsidy Scheme** 

- ★ Target residents: Elderly [aged 65 and above] & Children [born on Apr 2, 2002 ~ Sep 30, 2016]
- ◆ Self-burden: 1,000 yen/ per injection (Please pay to the clinic directly.)

  [Junior high school children Elderly: once a year; Primary children and under: twice a year]
- ♦ Vaccination period: Elderly [Oct 1, 2017 ~ Jan 31, 2018] & Children [Oct 1, 2017 ~ Mar 31, 2018]
- ◆ Those who intend to receive the vaccine, please make your appointment at any clinic in Hakuba.
