Child Medical Expenses Reimbursement Scheme

Change of reimbursement policies from August 1

From August 1, 2018, the payment policy of Child Medical Expenses Reimbursement Scheme is changed as follows.

• When your child visits a medical institution within Nagano Prefecture

WHEN	Until July 31	From August 1

PAYMENT METHOD	By presenting the "Reimbursement qualification certificate", you pay 30% of the cost to the medical institution first and get refunded to your bank account at a later date.	qualification certificate", you are only required to pay up to ¥500 to the			

The new policy does not apply to all medical institutions outside Nagano Prefecture and some of the clinics in Nagano Prefecture.

Those who have visited clinics outside Nagano; or have forgotten to present the qualification certificate at the clinic will be required to pay 30% of the cost and file a claim form for getting the refund at the village office.
 Other terms of use are remained unchanged.

Earthquake experience vehicle

Japan is located along the so-called Pacific Ring of Fire, which is the most active earthquake belt in the world. It is said that Japan is prone to 2-3 earthquakes (1,500 per year) and about 1,000 tremors a day. A large earthquake can destroy a whole city and take away thousands of lives in less than 10 seconds.

The earthquake experience vehicle can simulate the exact movement of an earthquake by vibrating its body. It travels around the city, enables you to experience a great earthquake's shake. By experiencing the shake, it can increase the awareness of disaster preparedness.

Schools, private organizations and business groups are welcomed to contact North Alps Wide Area Hokubu Fire Station to send the vehicle to your area for a disaster drill.

To all foreign nationals: Guide for preventing illegal working

In Japan, not only the illegal workers but also the employers who offer the job to such workers will face infringements or civil penalties.

Since the introduction of the new Residence Card system in July 2012, the status of residency can be easily confirmed on the residence card. Limitations on work type or working hours depend on one's status of residency.

Employers have a full responsibility to make sure they are not employing, referring or contracting illegal workers; employees should also present the residence card or the Certificate of Authorized Employment to prove that they are permitted to work.

Definition of illegal working:

(1) Overstaying	/	illegal	<u>staying</u>	(2)
<u>foreigners</u>				

E.g.

- Foreigners who enter Japan illegally / overstay in Japan and work
- Foreigners who work after they have received a deportation order

Foreigners who have not been granted a work permit from the Immigration Bureau

E.g.

- Foreigners who enter Japan with a short-term visitor visa and work
- Foreigners who have a student visa / who has applied for refugee status works without a permission for part-time job


③The job nature is not included in the visa or the working hours exceed the limit

E.g.

- Foreigner who have been granted a visa for working as a cook or a teacher but actually doing unskilled job
- A foreign students who work over the permitted working hours
