◆ Sep 9 The "Kyukyu-no-hi": AED Training in Omachi

In Japan, First-aid day is set on Sep 9 and is called "Kyukyu-no-hi(救急の日)". Since 2004, the Fire Department has been promoting AED(Automated External Defibrillator) use in public places, encouraging the public to learn how to use an AED when a person requires CPR(Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation) emergently. AED saves thousands of lives each year.

An AED training is held on Sep 9, 9 A.M.~ Noon, at North Alps Wide Area Fire Department(head quarter). Free of charge. Certificate will be distributed to all participants.




NOTIFICATION

The new NHI card is yellow-green in color. You should use the new card from Oct 1 and discard the old one to prevent confusion.
