For Foreign Residents /For Those Who Are Hiring Foreign Residents

Procedures prior to departure from Hakuba at village office

When moving out of Hakuba to another municipality or when moving abroad, filing of a move-out notification at Resident Division of Hakuba Village Office in advance is necessary. A move-out notification can be submitted 14 days before your scheduled move-out day. Please make sure you or your foreign employees have completed all necessary procedures before leaving Hakuba.

> Moving to another municipality:

A move-out certificate will be issued immediately after one has reported his/her moving at the village office. Please be aware that a new address cannot be registered at the other municipality without the certificate. (Note: New address is needed when you submit the move-out notification)

> Moving abroad:

Submission of move-out notification is necessary even if you have a plan to come back with a re-entry permit. Especially for those who have joined the National Health Insurance Scheme, you have to pay the insurance tax for the period that you are out of Japan if you leave without filing a move-out notification properly.

For discarding or transferring ownership of your light motor vehicle (Kei-jidosha) before the start of the new taxable year

In Japan, Light Motor Vehicle Tax (Kei-jidosha-zei) is levied on car owners on a yearly basis, based on the registration record as of April 1 of every year. In other words, the owners as of April 1 are required to pay the annual tax for their kei-cars. Please complete necessary procedures ASAP by March 31 to avoid extra expenses for your own interests.

- *2. For individuals, unregistered private seal is acceptable; however the vehicle is owned by a corporation, registered seal of the representative is required.

- ※5. For a corporation, one of the following is required; certified copy of commercial registration(商業登記簿謄本), certificate of registered matters (登記事項証明書) or company seal registration certificate, issued within 3 months.
- X6. Necessary in the case of the change of user.
- *7. If the submitter who presents at the office is not a family member living with the car owner, a power of attorney is required.
