

#### •Unacceptable items:

- ① Normal recycling paper and magazines (Please put them out on the designated recycling day.)
- (2) Heat-sensitive paper, fax paper, receipt, crimped postcard, photo, adhesive sheet, carbon paper, non-carbon paper and other kinds of special textured paper


